Meet Lily Clarke

Lily Clarke is a powerhouse. She is a firefighting, business-building scientist, and a participant in multiple programs sponsored by the Women's Foundation of Montana, including GUTS! (Girls Using Their Strengths) leadership program, PowerHouse Montana, and the AAUW Start Smart wage negotiation class. Lily was also recently awarded the \$15,000 John Rufatto Business Challenge award for her new business High Morel, that produces mushrooms while remediating brewery wastewater. Lily shared her wisdom on the challenges facing young women today. "Young women are raised to believe they can be anything they want to be, but when they look around, they see that isn't true. We need to see more women in leadership and in diverse positions to show us what's possible." Lily also highlighted the importance of having a mentor. She attributes her success to "having an adult outside my family who cared about me, cheered me on, and held me responsible for my actions."


