480 - PowerHouse Members

We created connection and knowledge-sharing through our PowerHouse Montana project. This year we added more than 100 new PowerHouse members to our online platform at powerhousemt. org. Eight Montana communities held 52 PowerHouse gatherings, bringing women together to learn and identify mentors and partners. One of our most active groups is in rural Wolf Point, where an average of 20 women gather most months, pictured left.

This year we celebrated our Trailblazers, the women who accepted the challenge, 20 years ago, to build a fund to work toward a brighter future for women and girls in Montana forever. We have now invested more than \$850,000 toward that goal. Thank you Trailblazers! In 2018, we invested more than \$60,000 in 18 new grants to organizations serving women and girls across the state. • Ensure All Women Have the Tools, Skills and Opportunity to Reach Their Full Economic Potential


- Advance Montana Women's Power and Influence
